
Occasions to Remember

Her book affords readers access to entertaining done well, with access to private homes around Palm Beach. The pages are full of photos, tips, and go-to recipes from some of Palm Beach's most notable hosts and hostesses.

A few tips from the book that you can apply whether entertaining big or small include:

- Ambassador Nancy Rinker always shows guests she cares about them by "creating a welcoming atmosphere and an enjoyable experience".
- Patrick Park believes that music sets the mood and is even more important than the food in creating a memorable occasion.
- Kathryn Vecellio and Karin Luter shared similar sentiments with readers. Relax and have a good time, then your guests will too. By planning ahead, you can then focus on your guests and enjoy the festivities.
- Finally author Annie Falk suggests that in addition to wines and specialty cocktails, offer sparkling water for non-drinkers. Don't forget to serve it in the same glass as your alcoholic beverages to make the teetotalers feel at ease.
